<p>PE Miss Cassidy</p>	<p><u>Multi skills:</u></p> <p>Pupils will continue to attend a sports session once a week at Lancaster and Morecambe College, a multi-skills sports session will be delivered giving pupils the opportunity to explore their fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling, hitting a target, dribbling with both hands and feet and kicking a ball.</p>	
<p>Life Skills Miss Cassidy</p>	<p><u>AIM Awards</u> <u>Entry Level Award in Independent Living:</u></p> <p>As part of our weekly life skills lessons, we visit local supermarkets to buy items of food for the school tuck shop. This term we will continue to write our own shopping lists and we will be working on finding items in shops independently. Visiting a variety of supermarkets in the area allows pupils to have different experiences and for them to gain the skills and confidence to be able to shop independently in the future.</p> <p>Pupils also complete an external accreditation during their time in KS4.
