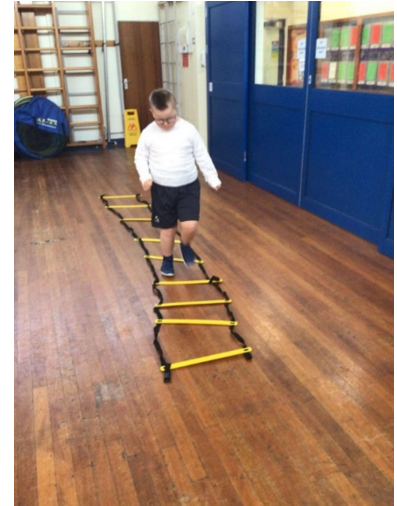
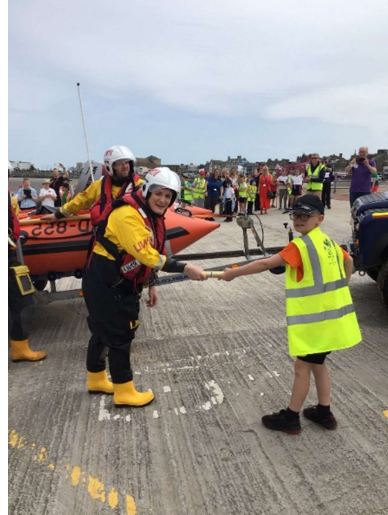


PE and Sport Premium Funding 2022-2023

We work hard at Morecambe Road to try and provide a varied and exciting programme of sport and PE. We strive to ensure that our children understand how important it is to stay fit and healthy. Last year we were very proud to be awarded the gold sports mark in recognition of our commitment to sport and PE across our school.

As a school community we were delighted when the government announced that every primary school in the country would continue to receive a substantial sum of money that must be used to raise levels of participation and enable children to make life-long positive choices.

This year (2022/23) our school plans to use the funding include:

- Joining both the Lancaster and Heysham school partnerships to enable links to be made with different coaches and sports leaders who could offer our children a varied range of activities as well as allowing participation into a broad range of competitions.
- Broaden access to swimming for all KS2 children to support them in gaining confidence and swimming ability in the water.

- Provide training and implement the new cross curricular orienteering programme across all of primary.
- Organise and participate in Outdoor Adventurous activities across all of primary.
- Continue our links with local sports centres, schools and Morecambe Football club to provide a varied programme of sports and activities for our children to engage in.
- Welcome different coaches into school; including Enjoyaball to encourage the development of different skills including fundamental movement skills.
- Purchase new resources to enable high quality and exciting PE to take place.
- Provide staff training so that children continue to access high quality provision and a varied extra curricular activity timetable.
